Our Learning Objectives are:

- ◆ Provide participants with an understanding of the basic skills for humor, stand-up, and comedy
- ◆ Provide participants with an understanding of how humor can be used to foster collegiality, cooperation, team building, improved public speaking skills, and environments that are more conducive to exploring new ideas
- ◆ Provide a fun experience building collaboration and collegiality

The seminar will discuss and demonstrate how improv and standup comedy can be used in leadership roles, including team building, enhancing creativity, and having fun. Skills and techniques used in stand-up can be used for a variety of different effects, including public speaking, establishing a conducive environment, fostering personal bonds, general writing skills for effective messaging, and performativity and teaching. Improv skills that will be taught include supporting, listening and engaging people, finding agreement, and leading and learning in innovative ways. These improv skills can be used to explore one's own take on work traits, personality, and creativity.

This seminar will focus on discussion, hands-on exercises, group and paired work, and practice and feedback.

Eric Biltonen grew up in Virginia and holds a Ph.D. in Agriculture and Resource Economics from Colorado State University. He formerly worked as an international development consultant based in Southeast Asia, where he lived for nearly a decade. He travelled to nearly 30 different countries, consulting on water resources and infrastructure projects.
