GUIDELINES

Juneau County 4-H Leaders Association annually awards scholarships totaling up to \$2,000. Applicants must include 4-H Record Book with application. Individuals awarded the scholarship are required to **submit proof of passing 1st semester college grades and proof of second semester course enrollment prior to May 1st of the following year before the scholarship money will be issued**. Individuals who do not meet submission deadline automatically forfeit awarded funds.

DEADLINE TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS: MAY 1ST

Applications postmarked after May 1st will not be eligible for consideration.
