- d. Remain in the assigned program area at all times.
- e. Tobacco, alcohol, and use of non-prescribed drugs is illegal and prohibited by 4-H.
- f. Show respect for yourself and others at all times.
- g. Treat program areas, shooting areas, and vehicles with respect. You will be held responsible for damage, theft, or misconduct in which you participate.
- h. Assist other members of the group and include all youth in activities.
- i. Seek the best from yourself. Be proud of who you are and what you accomplish.

CONSEQUENCES: (for failing to follow Code of Conduct) You will:

- a. Explain your actions to the adults in charge.
- b. Accept the consequences of your actions.
- c. Have the adult in charge contact your parent/guardians, or UW-Extension personnel to see that action is taken.
