☐ Filled out Declaration Form on page 2 of this document
The above 3 items need to be dropped off at the Extension Office, 220 E. State St., Room 104, Mauston by Nov. 17.

☐ Sign up for a face to face interview being held on Wed., Dec. 3 (3:30-6pm) or Sat., Dec. 6 (9-11am). There will be an online sign up opportunity that you will be notified of after your declaration submission is received.
☐ Develop a 4-H resume and submit the day of your scheduled interview.
☐ Participate in your scheduled face-to-face interview.

Scholarship is available for 1 educational experience per year. If you choose to do more than 1 educational experience or repeat an experience, those fees will be your responsibility.

COSTS LISTED ON THE TABLE ARE ESTIMATES

The Juneau County 4-H Leaders' Association covers 40% of educational experience costs for 1 educational experience per member per year up front when payment is due to the state office. Scholarship recipients will receive an additional 20% reimbursement of the total cost of the experience if they fulfill reimbursement requirements upon return from their experience. You may also choose to repeat educational experiences (example: Summer Academy). If you do that, the second year's fee is your responsibility. If you take more than one educational experience in a single year, the second fee is your responsibility. Please address questions to the 4-H Educator or to the Juneau County 4-H Leaders' Association.

Goals of the educational experiences: learn about oneself, meet new people, stretch your comfort zone, acquire new skills, and apply those skills to life, bring back new information to teach your peers- repeat.
