****Enrolled members who register but do not attend camp will be REQUIRED to pay \$225 (full camp fee of \$275 minus the \$50 they paid up front at registration) unless Hardship/Special Circumstances letter is submitted and approved by the Juneau County 4-H Leaders' Association no later than the Sept. 4, 2026 Leaders' meeting****

- Enjoy unstructured supervised free time
- Make friends from 5 counties and enjoy the company of great youth counselors and chaperones!
